The Regular Meeting of Citizen's Advisory Council was called to order at 6:00 P.M. Members present were Ryan Knox, Darius Jackson, DeCarlo Garcia, Narissa Jenkins, Felton Barnes, Teryn Chavez.

1. Called to Order

Mr. Knox called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

The pledge was recited by those in attendance.

3. Approve Agenda

Mr. Knox asked for action on the Agenda.

The agenda was approved by a unanimous vote.

4. Mayor's Time

Mayor Whitten informed the Board that a member has resigned, and he is currently looking for a replacement.

Mayor Whitten introduced Mr. Bolduc, City Manager to review the vehicle wrap designs for the police cars.

Mr. Bolduc, City Manager reviewed each of the designs with the Board.

Discussion ensued.

Mayor Whitten discussed the cancellation of the New Year's Eve event that was to take place on Mainstreet, but the Mayor did do a virtual countdown and spoke about his vision for the year 2021 of "Raising the Bar".
